



Community Capital Fund Launches Youth Neighborhoods Rising Fund

Summary:

The Neighborhoods Rising Fund (NRF) is a unique funding collaborative that annually provides grants (up to \$5,000) for community-driven and neighborhood-led revitalization projects and initiatives in low- to moderate-income neighborhoods throughout the Greater Kansas City region. In 2023, CCF has launched a Youth Neighborhoods Rising Fund. Like NRF, Youth NRF's mission will be to fund small but mighty projects, created and managed by high schoolers.

Youth NRF:

Teams of at least 4 youth, supported by an adult advisor, will be eligible to apply for neighborhood grants up to \$5,000 to improve their communities. Youth projects will have to align to one of NRF's funding areas: Celebration of Arts and Culture, Environmental Stewardship, Public Safety, Digital Inclusion, Neighborhood Clean-Ups, Membership Development + Social Cohesion, Creating or Maintaining Public Spaces, Parks + Gardens. Process Overview:

- Youth teams should be organized and supported by schools, nonprofit or neighborhood associations that have experience supporting and managing youth engagement efforts.
- Application will include a required pre-application survey to determine the organization's capacity to support youth team.
- The invitation only Youth NRF application should be submitted by the youth team and outline their NRF project.
- Project goals and milestones will be aligned to these measurements: the number of
 volunteers involved in the project, the number of people served or engaged by the project,
 whether the project resulted in an increase in the sense of community or people involved in
 the neighborhood, budget, and more.
